

# Girl Gymnasts Place 2nd at County Meet

The Ramona Girls' Gymnastics Club took second place at the Riverside County Gymnastics meet held at Moreno Valley High School on Saturday, April 25.

Seven schools participated in the meet with only El Centro winning over Ramona.

There were six categories which the girls took part in. They were: tumbling, floor exercise, vaulting, unevens, balance beam and all-around.

In the tumbling competition, of the seven girls who participated (Terri Adams, Lynn Jeppsen, Barbara Wickers, Debbie Stewart, Debbie Johns, Jeanette McDonnell and Terri Gross), four won awards. First (Terri Adams), 2nd (Terri Gross), fifth (Debbie Johns), and seventh (Debbie Stewart).

Terri Gross again took second place in the floor exercise event with Debbie Stewart taking fourth and Barbara Wickers capturing seventh place.

Debbie Erickson, Jamie Cloud, Cathy Corrison, Debbie Lemley, Cathy Torres and Terri Gross took part in the vaulting exercise with Jamie Cloud (2nd), Cathy Corrison (6th), and Cathy Torres (10th).

In the uneven category the only Ramona girl to win was Cathy Corrison who placed sixth.

Ramona did not place in the balance beam event.

Terri Gross and Debbie Johns took first and second places in the all-around event. Other girls who participated in this category were Cathy Torres and Cathy Corrison.

The girls again demonstrated their skills Friday evening when they performed for the Orange County Epilepsy Society.

The club is now practicing for the second Annual Girls' Invitational meet to be held Sunday, May 24, at San Bernardino Valley College at 1:00 p.m.
